COVID-19 Achievement Award

Building Services Engineering plays a significant and important role in tackling the job of creating safe and healthy environments. This Award recognises the remarkable work that Building Services professionals with the Building Services supply chain have undertaken and contributed to combat the effects of COVID-19.

The Award recognises, celebrates and be presented for the outstanding achievements of individuals, teams, organisations, projects, products or services by assessing the challenges they have faced across the full range of activities in the built environment, and the impact they have made in responding to unprecedented circumstances in 2020.

Award

- **COVID-19 Achievement Award**

Who should enter

Facilities managers, building developers/owners, maintenance contractors, individuals, manufacturers or companies etc.

Eligibility

Entries in this category must be from Hong Kong :

- For an existing building or existing buildings in Hong Kong where the **enhanced protective measures were implemented in 2020**, or
- For a new project or projects which is **specifically designed and constructed in 2020** to cope with COVID-19 pandemic, or
- For products, solutions, researches or innovations **introduced or launched in Hong Kong in 2020**.

Judging criteria

Successful entries will give details of as many of the following elements of the project as possible:

- Details of the individual, team, organisation, project, product or service involved.
- Explain the situation, task and the challenges, or constraints and how these were overcome.
- Details of the initiative, action or response and what was achieved. Describe the success of the initiative and its impacts (intended and unintended).

- How will the learning from these achievements be shared and continue to have an impact within the organisation(s) involved and more widely?
- Explain what is it about this achievement that makes you proud to work in Building Services. Why should you, your team or nomination win a COVID-19 Achievement Award?
